



Adande maintenance & cleaning guide

This manual explains how to properly clean and maintain your Adande refrigerated drawer unit for optimal performance, hygiene, and longevity. You'll need the following to complete the guide:



Bristled brush



Stainless steel cleaner



Soapy water



Clean cloths



All-purpose cleaner



Degreaser

1

Insulated container

Unplug the unit. Empty the drawer & pull it fully open & lift the container out using the side lift points. Place on top of the unit & inspect it for cracks before cleaning (replace immediately if damaged). Wipe surface with warm water and mild detergent, dry thoroughly.

Cleaning the internal plastic diffuser & seal

With the container removed, inspect the plastic diffuser & seal located on the ceiling of the unit for damage & replace if necessary. Clean the surface using warm water & mild detergent. Dry completely with a clean cloth before continuing.

Cleaning the drawer runners

Fully extend the drawer & brush away any food debris or dirt. ⚠️ Do NOT wash the runners, as this removes the grease required for smooth operation. Ensure all debris is removed.

Cleaning the condenser

Locate the condenser at the rear/base of the unit & inspect for dust buildup. Use a stiff-bristled brush, such as a paintbrush, to remove debris by brushing toward the base. Clean at least once per month to maintain efficient cooling performance.

Cleaning the stainless steel base & external surfaces

After cleaning the condenser, wipe the internal base with mild detergent or stainless steel cleaner to remove debris. Inspect external metal panels for damage. Clean external surfaces using warm water & mild detergent. Then carefully lift the insulated container using the side lift points & lower it back into the unit.

Cleaning the Display Panel

Lightly wipe the display panel with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris. Do not use harsh chemical cleaners, as they may damage the rubber buttons. Ensure the panel is dry before returning the unit to operation.



Recommended maintenance & cleaning schedule

Component	Cleaning Frequency
White Storage Container	Weekly
Drawer Seal	Daily (busy kitchens) / Weekly minimum
Internal Metal Surfaces	Weekly
Plastic Diffuser	Weekly
Drawer Runners (Debris removal only)	Weekly
Condenser	Monthly minimum
External Surfaces	Weekly
Display Panel	Weekly
